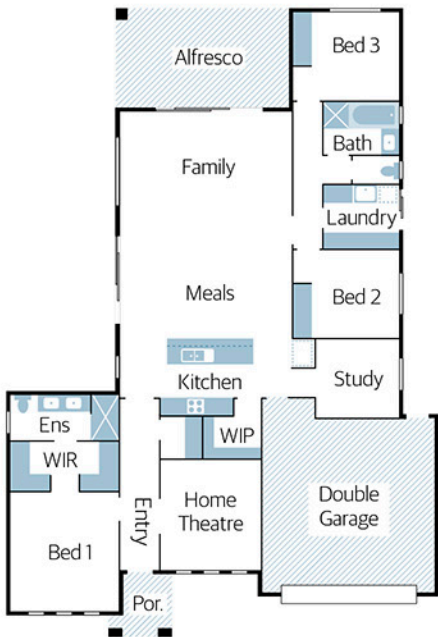

HIA judges' comments: This open and light-filled home has taken into account the needs of the families in the local area. It has carefully considered how a family will live. Bright and open with a feeling of space.
About the home: Designed for easy living, this spacious, zoned home allows for privacy as well as

ample space for family time together. It has three bedrooms plus a large study (or guest fourth bedroom for extended family) and two separate living zones and an alfresco to relax in. A walk-in store room and a walk-in pantry are other pluses, and the Acacia design also allows for plenty of backyard space so children can play cricket, or you could add a swimming pool.
The builder says: Oakford Homes' sales consultant Raphael Dona says the Acacia is an excellent family home as it is secure, has a good connection to the outdoors, and multiple areas to live in. "There is excellent viewing from the inside of the

home to the outside rear garden, so parents can watch children play due to the amount of large windows and sliding doors," he says.
